Virus spread as a result of close contact with people . Need for social distancing	All	Training: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing maintained • RA with additional measures noted + AA COVID 19 poster • Majority of courses to be held outside (outside open barns available) • Use of filming may be used in training to provide feedback, as relevant • Manikin used for aerial rescue practice • If need to use indoors – workbenches spread out to enable social distancing/ large door open (weather dependent) • Workshops are well ventilated • Inspection of maintenance by instructor or assessor – student asked to step away / screens can be added to benches • Masks can be worn in workshop – as weather gets colder and doors are shut • Course numbers remain small – max 4 people per course • Largely only 1 course running on site at a time. Where 2 courses are running or an assessment, they are allocated different workshops and outside areas.
Contamination of equipment	All	Training: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Site, course & day specific RA pre-populated. This is printed on the back of the feedback form – all attendees will have their own copy to sign. Collected at end as evidence that RA has been read. • Hand sanitiser in workshop, including individual pots on workbenches (wiped daily) • Gloves to be worn. All informed prior to training. • Learners to bring own flask/ food • Outside hand washing / hand sanitiser station available • Own kit to be used. If hiring – have a kit allocated at the start. • PPE clothing washed following use – taking into account manufacturer’s instructions. • Paperwork – can be emailed if preferred. Course work prepared in office by one person – a few days prior to the course. Lantra paperwork to remain in envelope until course • Disinfectant available
